

# Helpful Information for Annie's Surf Shack

# Aloha, Guests!

Welcome to Annie's Surf Shack! Here's everything you need to know for a smooth and enjoyable stay. Visit us at <u>www.anniessurfshack.com</u> for more details.

# Key Details:

- 1. **Door Code:** Active from 4:00 PM on arrival day; expires at 10:00 AM on departure day.
- 2. Wi-Fi: Network: "TC871TE1" or "TC871TE1-5G" | Password: "TC8717T3EDDE1"
- 3. **TV & Cable:** Use TV remote to power on, arrow down to "Cable Box," press OK. Use cable remote to change channels.
- 4. Security Screen Door Keys: In a tray or bolw on the bar (2 keys with lanyards). We leave the door open and screen locked when out sunbathing or swimming.
- 5. Sofa Bed Linens: Sheets, blanket, and pillows in the bedroom closet.
- 6. **Dishwasher:** Door is stiff give it a firm pull to open.
- 7. **Bathroom Fan:** Passive system (no switch) tied to the building's central fan. A small fan in the bathroom helps circulate air.
- 8. **Breeze Warning:** Opening the front and lanai doors creates a strong breeze. Pictures are Velcro-secured – please don't pull them off (it damages the paint).
- 9. Ceiling Fans:
  - **Front Room:** Switch by bookshelf near lanai window; remote on kitchen bar.
  - **Bedroom:** Switch by the door (when open); remote is on the wall next to the switch.
  - Ensure switches are "on" before using remotes.

- 10. **Coffee Filters:** Above the microwave.
- 11. **Parking Pass:** Place on the car's dashboard (1 per unit). Extra passes in the top farright kitchen drawer (facing water).
- 12. Lanai Rule: No hanging clothes or towels over the railing use wall hooks or bathroom instead.
- 13. Ice: Trays are in the freezer; use a metal bowl to store ice. Fill trays your first night!
- 14. **Oven/Stove Safety:** Knobs turn on easily if bumped keep stovetop clear when not cooking.
- 15. **Towels:** Beach towels on bedroom bed at check-in; bathroom towels under the sink or in drawers.
- 16. **Condiments:** Wet items (e.g., oils) are removed between guests as per the cleaning contract for health and pest control reasons. Salt, pepper, and spices provided; check cupboards for leftover oils or coffee (use at your own risk).

### **Annie's Surf Shack Tips**

### **Island Living Hacks:**

- 1. **Sleep Like Locals:** Try the memory foam sofa bed with the security screen door locked, the front door half-open, and the lanai door wide open. Cool breezes and the sounds of the ocean all night! (Note: Big waves can get loud.)
- 2. **Turtle Spotting:** Mornings are best they munch seaweed off the seawall. Please don't disturb them on the beach.
- 3. Whale Watching: November to May, right from the lanai!
- 4. **First Night Takeout:** Grab food from China Boat across the street tasty, reliable, and perfect for a sunset lanai dinner.
- Bus to Lahaina: Skip driving! Bus 28 (\$2 one-way, \$4 all-day) stops a block left (Kahana Outrigger) or right (Dollie's Pub & Café). Takes ~30 mins, with a Whalers Village stop.
- 6. Kona Winds: If breezes are light, use ceiling fans and two floor fans for comfort.
